Further Tata Steel Limited Wires Division Jamshedpur (TSWDJ) declare that effective date of the scheme of Amalgamation amongst Tata Steel Limited and The Indian Steel & Wire Product Limited is September 1, 2024.

After the full deliberations, it was unanimously decided that Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. SIA/JH/MIN/ 551550 /2025 has requested to transfer (transfer of ownership) of Environmental Clearance in favour of "M/s Aditya Enterprises (Proprietor: Shri Chintu Kumar Bhagat)" for which he has submitted "No Objection Certificate" affirming that the Environmental Clearance will be transferred in favour of "M/s Aditya Enterprises (Proprietor: Shri Chintu Kumar Bhagat)" and they do not have any objections regarding the transfer of Environmental Clearance and all the terms and conditions of Environmental Clearance dated 08.11.2019 shall be complied by "M/s Aditya Enterprises (Proprietor: Shri Chintu Kumar Bhagat)". Deputy Commissioner, Sahibgani has also transferred the lease deed vide GRN Number: 2504046445, dated: 23.08.2025 in the favour of "M/s Aditya Enterprises (Proprietor: Shri Chintu Kumar Bhagat)". District Mining Officer, Sahibgani vide memo no. 1607/M, dated 30.08.2025 certified that said project falls under grid no. 2 and production is within the over all permissible production limit. The DMO also stated that this certificate is issued in the light of order passed by Hon'ble NGT on 22.12.2021 in OA No. 23/2017/EZ, O.A. no. 776/2018 and O.A. no. 373/2019. It also states this certificate is issued in compliance of report of Expert Committee.

After the full deliberations, it was unanimously decided that Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2018-19/2232/2019/685, dated 08.11.2019 is being transferred to "M/s Aditya Enterprises (Proprietor: Shri Chintu Kumar Bhagat)" with the same terms and conditions under which prior Environmental Clearance was granted by SEIAA, Jharkhand for the same validity period subject to satisfactory compliance to all stipulated terms and conditions. "M/s Aditya Enterprises (Proprietor: Shri Chintu Kumar Bhagat)" is directed to obtain Consent to Operate from the

  - I. Bandarjori Stone Deposit of Shri Ravi Shankar Kumar, Village: Bandarjori, Anchal: Jarmundi, Distt.: Dumka, Jharkhand (2.242 Ha) (Proposal no.: SIA/JH/MIN/550493/2025).

The SEAC has examined the above project proposal and unanimously made following recommendation:

"The PA's vide online application no. SIA/JH/MIN/ 550493 /2025 has requested for necessary correction in EC issued vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2025-26/3812/2025/305, dated 23.07.2025. The EC issued had inadvertently mentioned the name of the addressee as Fadar Ansari, S/o Late Awedin Ansari, R/o Village: Jogikhop, P.O.: Rajbandh Palasi, P.S.: Shikaripara, Distt.: Dumka, Jharkhand: 816118 in place of Shri Ravi Shankar Kumar, S/o: Shri Upendra Prasad Singh, House no. 298, Ward no. 4, Williams Town, Sri Krishnapuri, P.O. + P.S.: Deoghar, Distt.: Deoghar, Jharkhand.

The SEAC considered the same and recommends for issuance of corrigendum EC with corrected details as stated above. Other terms & conditions mentioned in the previous EC letter no. EC/SEIAA/2025-26/3812/2025/305, dated 23.07.2025 shall remain the same".

Hence, SEIAA considered the Recommendations of SEAC as mentioned above and unanimously decided to accept the recommendations of SEAC and accordingly will issue the corrigendum in EC. The terms and conditions, mentioned in the letter no.: EC/SEIAA/2025-26/3812/2025/305, dated 23.07.2025 shall remain the same.

- 16. SEIAA considered the Recommendations of SEAC in its 126<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 09<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2025 for grant of Corrigendum Terms of Reference to the following Minor Mineral (Stone Mining) project:
  - I. Paharpur Stone Block of M/s Ravi Shankar Kumar (Prop. : Shri Ravi Shankar Kumar), Village : Paharpur, Tehsil : Dumri, Distt. : Giridih, Jharkhand (6.475 Ha) (Proposal no.: SIA/JH/MIN/ 550548/2025).

The SEAC has examined the above project proposal and unanimously made following recommendation:

"The PA's vide online application no. SIA/JH/MIN/ 550548 /2025 has requested for necessary correction in ToR issued vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2025-26/3813/2025/256, dated 23.07.2025. The ToR issued had, at one place inadvertently mentioned the

project name as Chandangaria Stone Deposit of M/s Swastik Mining Agency (Partners: Shri Nehal Kumar Chawda) at Village: Chandangaria, Anchal: Shikaripara, District: Dumka, Jharkhand (2.917 Ha) in place of Paharpur Stone Block of M/s Ravi Shankar Kumar (Prop.: Shri Ravi Shankar Kumar), Village: Paharpur, Tehsil: Dumri, Distt.: Giridih, Jharkhand (6.475 Ha).

The SEAC considered the same and recommends for issuance of corrigendum ToR with corrected details as stated above. Other terms & conditions mentioned in the previous ToR letter no. EC/SEIAA/2025-26/3813/2025/256, dated 23.07.2025 shall remain the same".

Hence, SEIAA considered the Recommendations of SEAC as mentioned above and unanimously decided to accept the recommendations of SEAC and accordingly will issue the corrigendum in EC. The terms and conditions, mentioned in the letter no.: EC/SEIAA/2025-26/3813/2025/256, dated 23.07.2025 shall remain the same.

17. Regarding EC applicability of the Bokaro Airport of M/s Bokaro Steel Plant (SAIL), Bokaro.

The SEAC again considered and examined the above matter and gave following recommendation in the instant matter:

"A mail sent by Mr. D.K. Saxena, CGM (Environment, Conservation & Sustainability), SAIL, Bokaro Steel Plant to SEIAA and DFO, Ranchi—cum- Member Secretary, SEAC seeking clarification on the applicability of requirement of EC on conversion of the Captive Bokaro Airport to Commercial (Public use) Airport.

It is to be noted that clarification in this regard has already been discussed in the 115th meeting of SEAC held on 23rd to 27th July, 2024 and further deliberated on the same issue in the 115th meeting of SEIAA held on 06th & 07th August, 2024. The outcome of deliberations and discussions of the SEIAA and SEAC meetings were communicated to concerned authorities.

The SEAC is of the opinion that no further deliberation in the matter is warranted in the matter as the details were very explicitly communicated by SEIAA.

Further, Mr. D.K. Saxena had personally come during SEAC meeting and he was again explained to his satisfaction about the applicability of requirement of EC on conversion of the Captive Bokaro Airport to Commercial (Public use) Airport.

The SEIAA may communicate the same to Mr. D.K. Saxena, CGM (Environment, Conservation & Sustainability), SAIL, Bokaro Steel Plant".

The said matter was already been discussed by SEAC in its 115<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2024 in which SEAC has provided following recommendation:

"As per EIA notification, 2006 as amended for time to time, Airport projects are listed under serial 7(a) of the scheduled. The projects are classified as follows:

- a. All new projects including airstrips, which are for commercial use are categorized as Category 'A' projects and to be appraised at the Central Level.
- b. All expansion projects, including airstrips which are for commercial use are categorized as Category 'B' projects and to be appraised at the State Level.

The SEAC has examined all the documents annexed with letter no. 31, dated 05.04.2024 from Member Secretary, SEIAA, Jharkhand addressed to the Joint Secretary, MoEF&CC, Govt. of India.

On examination of the documents it is seen that the existing Airport is a captive airport of M/s Bokaro Steel Plant (SAIL) and that it is not a commercial airport.

Now, the proposal is to convert this captive airport into a commercial airport.

Hence, the SEAC is of the view that as far as the commercial activities of the airport are concerned, it is to be considered as a new commercial airport.

Accordingly, it is to be considered as Category 'A' project and to be appraised at the Central Level".

Earlier the SEIAA in its 115<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 06<sup>th</sup> and 07<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 While examining of recommendation of 115<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2024 of SEAC, SEIAA also considered the 93<sup>rd</sup> MoM of SEIAA, Odisha held on 15.10.2022 which relates the similar matter pertaining to grant of EC of existing airport of SAIL - Rourkela Steel Plant under category 7(a) column 4: "All expansions projects, including airstrips, which are for commercial use" at the State Level.

## SEIAA was of the opinion that:

- i. Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA) has decided to develop the Bokaro Air Strip for operation of Commercial Flights under the Regional Connectivity UDAN Scheme of Govt. of India. This is an existing airport operating since early 1979 as a private airstrip for Bokaro Steel Plant earlier.
- ii. SAIL Bokaro Steel Plant is the Integrated Iron & Steel Plant and a Maharatna Company under Ministry of Steel which was established by Govt. of India in the year 1979 at Bokaro. SAIL- Bokaro has an Air Strip in Bokaro Steel for private use established in early eighties.
- iii. This proposal is for EC for Up-gradation of Bokaro Air Port (expansion case) under RCS-UDAN scheme of Govt. of India.
- iv. As per EIA Notification, 2006 as amended for time to time the said project will require Environmental Clearance.

In the 115<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEIAA held on 06<sup>th</sup> and 07<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 it was observed that there is difference of opinion between SEAC & SEIAA on the point that whether Environmental Clearance shall be given by SEIAA or MoEF&CC under schedule 7(a) of EIA Notification, 2006.

Therefore, MoEF & CC, Govt. of India may be required to provide clarification as to who will be the competent authority to accord Environmental Clearance i.e. either MoEF & CC or SEIAA.

18. The W.P.(C) No. 2726 of 2025 and W.P.(C) No. 4223 of 2025, M/s Tirupati Construction Vs The State of Jharkhand & Ors. filed in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand.

The SEIAA considered the order dated 27.08.2025 of the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand passed in W.P.(C) No. 2726 of 2025 and W.P.(C) No. 4223 of 2025, M/s Tirupati Construction Vs The State of Jharkhand & Ors, In which Hon'ble Court permitted to be withdrawn these writ petitions with the liberty to the writ petitioner to approach before the SEIAA by raising all the issues.

Hence, SEIAA unanimously decided that above matter will be taken up in the next meeting of SEIAA for consideration.
